Park Directors Update

- Girl Scout Presentation – Two local Girl Scout members made a presentation to the Board for their Silver Award project. The project they presented is to install a brick walkway in Memorial Park that connects the walking path to the flag pole. The presentation included information about the troop, who will do the work, where the material and equipment will come from and who will pay for everything. They have secured the assistance of a local landscaping contractor to assist in their efforts. Their goal is to have the project completed before Memorial Day. They will work closely with DS to ensure installation is complete and installed properly.

This will be discussed again at the April Board meeting and all the updates will be placed on one copy for the BOS.
