

From the Board of Supervisors ...

The Township is excited to announce the significant upgrades and further development of Guinea Lane Park. From residents to sports organizations, Guinea Lane Park is one of our most highly used parks by our community.

As part of our 2023 budget, the Township is prepared to construct a new 90' baseball field in the rear, right corner of the existing park. The field would be accompanied by a new parking lot and stormwater management facilities. Our sports organizations have been requesting this improvement for some time, and we are, fortunately, in the current position to be able to provide for it.

The field and stormwater facilities portion of the project was awarded to a responsible contractor this spring with construction commencing this summer. Our Public Works department will be installing the access driveway and parking lot.





To further enhance Guinea Lane Park, the pickleball courts are being resurfaced and re-lined to allow for more courts in the same footprint. Our goal is to always support a wide range of community activities that residents of all ages can participate in and enjoy.

Furthermore, the Warwick Township Board of Supervisors has remained committed to providing these projects without increasing property taxes since 2010 or issuing bonds to accrue debt.

Help keep pollution out of storm drains

Only rain in the drain! That's because storm drains and roadside ditches lead directly to our streams and rivers. So, any oil, pet waste, leaves, trash, or dirty water from washing your car that enters a storm drain gets into our streams and rivers.



What can you do?

Simple. These tips will help prevent pollutants from entering our streams, lakes and rivers:

- Keep all litter off the street and place it in receptacles so that it does not get washed down the storm drains.
- Keep leaves, grass clippings, and fertilizers out of storm drains.
- Do not dump motor oil, chemicals, pet waste, dirty or soapy water, or anything else down the storm drain.
- Place dog waste in a trash can. Do no leave it on your yard, in the street or place it in a storm drain. Pet waste can introduce disease-causing bacteria into our water supply.

Know Your Local Wildlife - Snakes



Did you know there are twenty-one (21) species of snakes found in Pennsylvania? Of these only three (3) throughout the state are venomous and it is unlikely you will run into a venomous species within the Township. Snakes are cold-blooded, which is why you will often find them basking in the sun on walking paths and rocks when the temperatures are cooler. More times than not snakes will be hiding in the summer to keep their bodies from getting too warm.

All Pennsylvania snakes are protected by the Fish and Boat Commission and do not have a reputation for doing property damage. You may find snake skins but that does not indicate they are living in your structures; snakes tend to enter our spaces to find food such as rodents. Snakes not only keep pest species in check, but they are also an important food source for other animals within our community. If you do encounter a snake don't fear as they will be out of sight in no time!

Township Ordinance Reminder

According to Township Ordinance 2002-8, Chapter 131 of the Warwick Township Code, Parks and Recreation Areas, §131-3 Prohibited Conduct – It shall be unlawful to bring or cause to be brought into any park, recreation or playground area any animal, except where posted. In those areas where posted, it shall be unlawful to permit any dog to be in any such area unless such dog is secured on a leash of not more than six feet in length. §131-3.8 Violations and Penalties – Any person violating any of the provisions of this article shall be punishable, upon conviction thereof, by a fine of not less than \$60 nor more than \$600 and costs of prosecution or by imprisonment in the Bucks County Prison for not more than 90 days, or by both fine and imprisonment. LEASH YOUR DOGS WHILE IN TOWNSHIP PARKS AND OPEN SPACE.

Bucks County Prison for not more than 90 days, or by both fine and imprisonment. LEASH YOUR DOGS WHILE IN TOWNSHIP PARKS AND OPEN SPACE. According to Township Ordinance 2010-2, Chapter 63 of the Warwick Township Code, Dogs and Other Animals, §63-2 Running at large prohibited – It shall be unlawful for any person owning, harboring or possessing any animal to permit said animal to run at large at any time upon any of the streets, roads, highways, or public grounds in the Township or upon the property of another person other than the owner, custodian or keeper of such animal. Any animal not penned or leashed or attended by or under the immediate personal control and supervision of its owner or some person capable of controlling said animal at all times shall be deemed to be running at large. §63-10 Violations and Penalties – Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this chapter shall, upon summary conviction before a District Judge, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$1,000, plus the charges for the maintenance of said animal and the costs of prosecution.

According to Township Ordinance 2005-7, Chapter 111 of the Warwick Township Code, Littering, §111-3 Prohibition against littering – It shall be unlawful for any person to throw, drop, discard or otherwise place garbage, refuse, litter or rubbish of any nature upon any public place or private property other than in a receptacle by the Township or the owner of the private property. Rubbish is defined as solid wastes consisting of combustible and noncombustible wastes, such as circulars, leaflets, pamphlets, wrappers, handbills, newspapers and any and all other printed material, cigarettes, cardboard, tin cans, YARD CLIPPINGS, LEAVES, WOOD, glass, building materials and other like materials, but not including political literature. §111-5 Violations and Penalties – Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be punished, upon conviction thereof, by a fine not to exceed \$1,000 and costs of prosecution or by imprisonment in the Bucks County Prison for not more than 90 days, or by both fine and imprisonment. PLEASE DO YOUR PART TO PICKUP YOUR TRASH, ANIMAL WASTE AND OTHER RUBBISH AND USE THE GARBAGE CANS PROVIDED IN THE PARKS.






