From the Board of Supervisors . . .

Creating a walkable community is an important component of the Township's Comprehensive Plan. In order to facilitate and accomplish that goal, the Township makes trail and sidewalk connections along some of our busiest roads a top priority. Last year, a pedestrian/bike lane was added along Stony Road from Turkeytrot Road to Bentley Drive, and sidewalks were added along York Road in front of A.H. Cornell

& Sons, the US Post Office and the First National Bank & Trust. We are currently focusing on filling sidewalks gaps along York Road.



For 2023, sidewalks are in progress between Paul B. Moyer & Sons and Jamison Carpets, and between the Outback Steakhouse and the Bucks Club.

Planning has begun to add additional sidewalks from the Paradiso Restaurant to the Jamison Pour House for 2024. We are also looking into a trail connection from the Stover Mill development to Tulip Drive.

In order to install sidewalks along York Road, easements must be acquired from the property owners where the sidewalks would be placed and a Highway Occupancy Permit must be acquired from PennDOT. Both of these prerequisites are time consuming and complex. We greatly appreciate the property owners that have executed easement agreements to allow these critical sidewalk connections.

A Note From The Warwick Tax Office

Real Estate tax bills for 2023 were mailed March 1st and the first week of July.

School Taxes are due at discount if paid by August 31st. Full payment is due by October 31st. If you did not pay the County Township tax bill, they are in penalty now. Liens for unpaid County Township Tax bills for 2023 will be turned over to Bucks County Tax Claim on December 31st. Liens for unpaid school taxes will be turned over to Portnoff Law Associates via the Central Bucks School District on December 31st.

Please update the Tax office of any address changes. New homeowners or deed changes should remember to apply for the Homestead reduction through Bucks County Board of Assessment by March 1, 2024.

This office collects only real estate taxes. The earned income and LST tax collector is Keystone Collections. You can contact them at 1-888-328-0565 or visit their website at www.Keystonecollects.com. File your local return with Keystone by April 15th. every year.



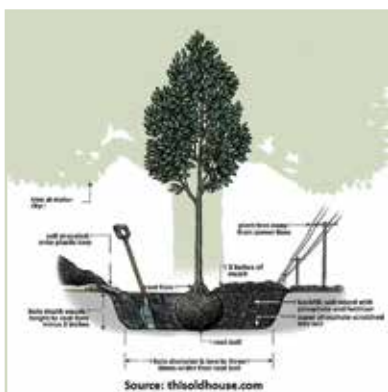
Moland House Garden

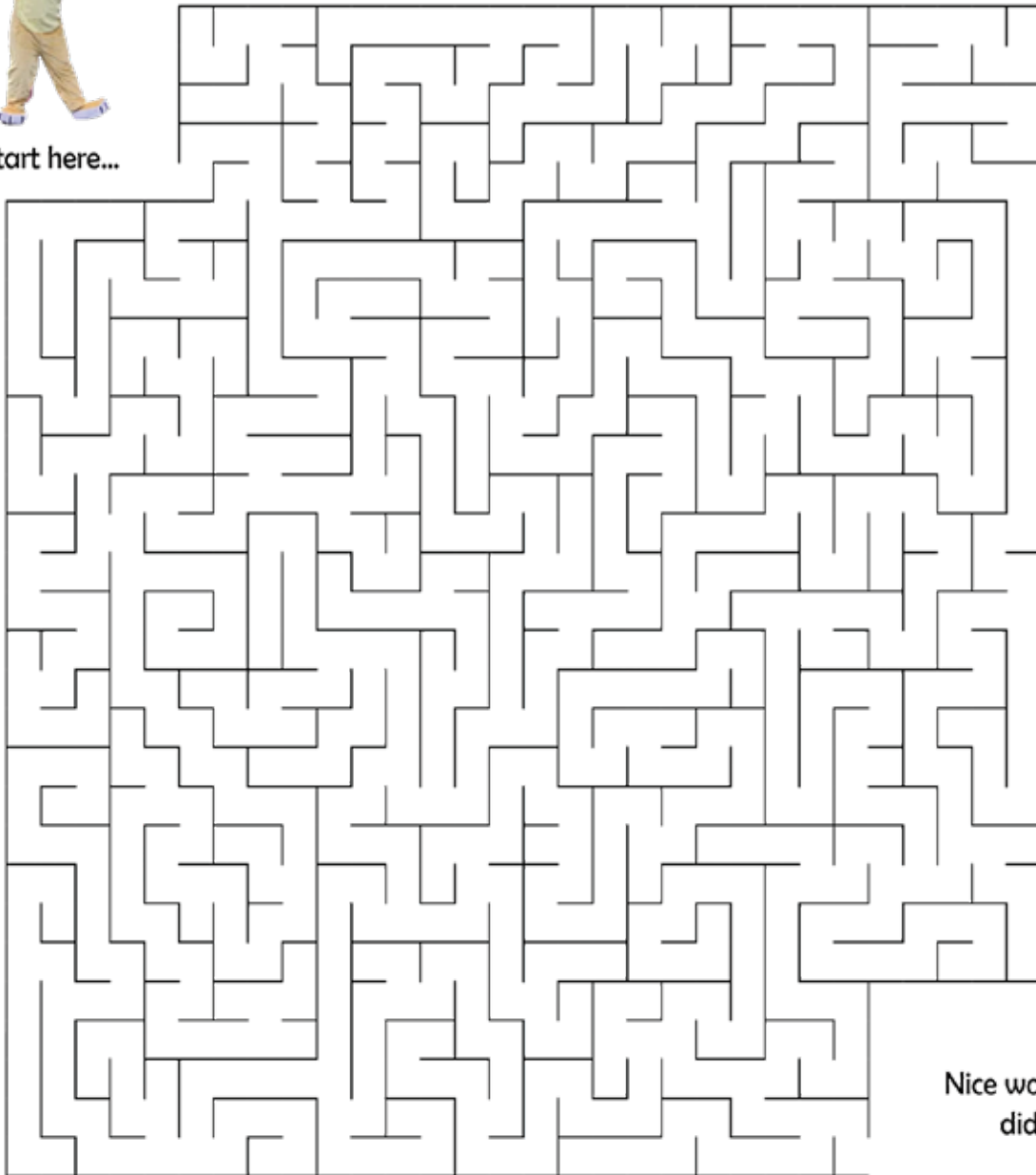

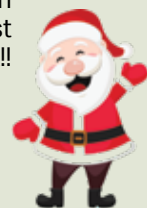

Safety Tips

Indoor Safety

Turn off computers. Stay off
corded phones, computers,
and other things that put
you in direct contact with
electricity or plumbing. You
can use a cell or cordless
phone.

Do not wash your hands,
bathe, shower, do laundry, or
wash dishes.



Outdoor Safety

- » If you can hear thunder, you are within striking distance of lightning. Look for shelter inside a home, large building, or a hard-topped vehicle right away.
- » Do not go under trees for shelter. There is no place outside that is safe during a thunderstorm.
- » Wait at least 30 minutes after hearing the last clap of thunder before leaving your shelter.
- » Stay away from windows and doors. Stay off porches.
- » There is no safe place outside. Places with only a roof on sports fields, golf courses, and picnic areas are not safe during a lightning storm. Small sheds should not be used.
- » If a person is struck by lightning, call 9-1-1. Get medical help right away.
