Job Description

**Job Objective / General Description:**

Performs the regular and recurring maintenance and landscaping of all Township public properties using grass cutting equipment such as zero-turn mowers, string trimmers, blowers and any authorized equipment available. Expected to perform all routine assignments independently following established policies, procedures and practices and following assigned work schedule.

**Supervision:**

Reports to the Director of Park and Recreation of Open Space. May report to other department heads when performing joint tasks. Receives close to moderate supervision, depending on experience and complexity of task.

**Minimum Education, Training and Experience Required:**

- Must have working familiarity with assigned maintenance equipment and maintenance methods and materials.
- Desirable to have a minimum of one year of previous experience in a similar position.
- Must possess a valid PA State driver's license.
- Must be able to pass mandatory random drug testing as required.
- Must be highly self-motivated and able to follow established procedures and meet standards while working unsupervised.
- Ability to understand and follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to occasionally, and as necessary, use sound judgment to solve problems and make decisions independently.

**Essential Job Functions:**

- Use power equipment and hand tools necessary to accomplish assigned tasks.
- Perform routine and recurring maintenance as required.
- Assist with projects requiring various tools and machinery as directed.
- Perform work in accordance with sound safety practices.
- May perform portions of the work of higher classified positions occasionally, as assigned.
- May perform duties of similar complexity in other departments as required or assigned.
- Must use a variety of hand and power operated tools and equipment.
