- Penn State Extension Master Gardeners presented a proposal to develop a sensory garden at Warwick Memorial Park. The sensory garden would become a unique garden among the Bucks County Penn State Extension demonstration gardens. The garden would include two primary components: An accessible sensory area with multiple beds – hearing, smell, touch, taste and sight; a labyrinth path that represents a journey to one’s center and back again out into the world.

 - The Park Board supports the idea but does not like the location that was selected. A few other options were discussed in the park.
 - The Park Board suggested looking at other options and possibly scaling back the size of the project.
 - The Master Gardeners will go back to the drawing board and present a new plan.
