Park Directors Update

Special Event Update

- DS reminded the Board of the date for this year's annual egg hunt scheduled for Saturday, March 28 at 1pm in the Community Park.
- DS informed the Board that we will be doing the Food Truck event again this year. We are partnering with a woman who runs these types of events, similar to the last two times we offered the event. She has all the connections with the food trucks and the township will essentially be the host of the event. The event will be called the "Warwick Township Fall Food Truck Festival" and is scheduled for Saturday, October 17 from 12pm-4pm. The location of the Middle Bucks Institute of Technology has been applied for and we are just waiting on approval.

- Capital Projects scheduled for 2026 – DS informed the Board of the projects that are budgeted for this year. These projects include:
 - New pickup truck
 - New mower (replace out of service unit)
 - Hampton Chase Park – Fencing will be installed around the playground
 - Community Park & Guinea Lane Park– Sunshades will be installed
 - Guinea Lane Park – Playground will be completed renovated. Old equipment and safety surface will be removed. New safety surface and all new equipment will be installed. This project will be completed with an LSA Grant, similar to the grant that was used to complete Recreation Station in Community Park.
 - Hidden Pond Park – Application has been submitted through the LSA Grant for a complete renovation of the playground. We may not find out until very late in 2025 or early 2026 if we get the grant or not so depending on the grant award, this may not happen until 2027.
